

- **Implementation of a Montreal Low Water Additional  
North Atlantic Trade**

Dear Customer,

This year the water levels of the St. Lawrence River have dropped below historic lows due to less snow over the winter, followed by an unseasonably warm and dry spring. Latest official forecasts do not show any improvement and the situation will most likely continue or even deteriorate in the next months.

We would like to inform you that with effect from **July 19, 2010** Hapag-Lloyd will implement a Low Water Additional for all cargo moving via the port of Montreal to and from Europe on the SLCS 1 and 2 services:

- **USD 100 per 20' Container**
- **USD 150 per 40' Container**
